- Develop and disseminate market and vendor publicity through the Market website, facebook page and other effective media channels.
- Ensure SNAP/EBT Market operations are in compliance with Market rules.
- Keep accurate records and complete required reports on time.
- Partner with Stevens County Food Shelf to purchase produce from growers.

Requirements:

- Ability to be at the Market in downtown Morris from 2:30 pm to 6 pm on Thursdays throughout the Market season plus ~ 2 hours media marketing/wk for \$1500 contract paid in 3 installments (June, August and October).
- Excellent marketing, communication and interpersonal skills.
- Excellent technology and social media skills.
- Interest/experience in locally grown food and community food security.
