## **VENDOR APPLICATION to Accept SNAP/EBT**

### **At the 2021 Morris Area Farmers Market**

Morris Area Farmers Market is authorized to offer EBT/SNAP (Electronic Benefit Cards for the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program, formerly known as Food Stamps) and redeem Market Bucks to augment purchasing power for SNAP participants.

**Vendors selling food and/or edible plants can redeem EBT/SNAP tokens for sales if they:**

- 1. Agree to follow all of the policies of the Morris Area Farmers Market.**
- 2. Acknowledge that using the Market's EBT services is a privilege and that the Market will suspend or terminate the vendor's SNAP/EBT authorization if policies are violated.**
- 3. Have informed anyone selling on the vendor's behalf of SNAP/EBT rules for product sales.**
