### to Accept SNAP/EBT at the 2023 Morris Area Farmers Market



Morris Area Farmers Market is authorized to deliver EBT/SNAP (Electronic Benefit Cards for the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program, formerly known as Food Stamps) and redeem incentives to augment purchasing power for SNAP participants.

SNAP benefits can be used to buy food and plants and seeds to grow food. SNAP cannot be used to buy:

- Any nonfood item, such as pet foods, household supplies like soap and paper products, or grooming items like toothpaste and cosmetics
- Any food that will be eaten at the Market
- Hot foods

Vendors selling food and/or edible plants can redeem SNAP tokens and incentives for sales if they:

1. Agree to follow Morris Area Farmers Market rules and regulations.
2. Abide by SNAP rules, acknowledging that participation will be terminated if rules are violated.
3. Agree to inform all sellers on your behalf of SNAP/EBT rules for product sales.
